## **Criteria for Ending AIS**

Academic Intervention Services will end when the student has successfully attained the district standards according to the State and/or district criteria for discontinuing services.

#### Recordkeeping

Record of the student's performance on state and/or local assessments used to determine the student's placement into AIS

Listing of the specific Academic Intervention Services provided and the dates the student received services

Copy of all parent notification(s), including initiation and termination of services Record of parent/teacher conference
