Controlled Dangerous Substance (possession, use, distribution, and/or under the influence) the student is deemed ineligible to participate in any and all extracurricular activities offered by the Bay Shore Union Free School District for the following time periods:

First violation - 90 Calendar Days

A student's first period of ineligibility from participation in extracurricular activities, upon application, may be reduced to 45 calendar days following the Committee's receipt of express written parental consent and other documentation confirming the student's regular attendance and completion of a pre-approved educational program deemed acceptable by the Bay Shore School District. The decision to reduce a student's first period of ineligibility from participation in extracurricular activities is within the sole and exclusive discretion of the Eligibility Committee.

Subsequent Violations - 180 Calendar Days

There is no application to reduce the ineligibility period for subsequent violations.
